Hello Members!

Hope this letter finds you well. It's that time of year again to close out the 2022-2023 year for the club and renew memberships for the next year.

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP: Let's start off with some good news; there are no fee increases for this upcoming year! Last year, the Board voted to reduce some fees to add spouses to the indoor range and to the long range. The 2023-2024 Single Member Annual Membership fee is still \$75, and the fee to add a legal spouse is only an additional \$25. To add a spouse onto your Indoor membership, the fee to add a spouse has decreased to \$25 (down from \$50) and the fee to add a spouse to your Long-Range membership has decreased to \$50 (down from \$100). If your spouse has not received official orientation, then your spouse will need to receive the Club's orientation, as with all new members. The Club is a family-oriented venue, and the Board wants to meet its mission to ensure your spouse can enjoy the facility with you.

If you participated in one of the club's work parties during the 2022-2023 membership year, you will be given a credit of \$25 off your Annual Membership fees, which reduces your Annual Membership fee to \$50. If this applies to you, you will see a sticker on your renewal submission form stating that "You may deduct \$25 off your total dues since you attended a work party." The Board has voted to continue with this work party credit during the upcoming 2023-2024 year as well. All fees are due by June 30, 2023.

Note: We no longer send out new RFID cards every year. The card you currently own will remain in service for as long as you continue to renew your membership. If renewal dues are not received by the end of the Membership year in June, the card will be deactivated. Upon receipt of dues, the card will be reactivated.

WORK PARTY: As a reminder, the work parties started again in May, and will occur on the 3rd Saturday of the month starting at 8:00AM throughout the spring, summer, and fall. For more information, please check out the Club's website or contact one of the Board members for additional details. This is a great way to help keep the Club's property in good condition and a great way for you to earn a \$25 credit toward your annual membership fee.

<u>INDOOR RANGE</u>: The Indoor Range fee will remain at \$50 per year. Your membership fees go toward maintaining the indoor range. This year we are looking at target retrievers. The backstop wall **allows the use of full metal jacket ammunition**. This is a significant upgrade and been in place since 2019!

TRAP HOUSE: The Club continues to maintain the new trap machine and it is in good working order. The Sunday morning trap league starts up again in May. Keep an eye on the Club calendar for details.

SECURITY: The Club upgraded its security camera system throughout the premises to ensure that the Club is a safe place for its members and guests.

1100 YARD RANGE: The long range has again been a huge hit this past year. There are a number of targets placed at varying distances from 300 yards and scattered out to the 1100-yard berm. The club is hosting long range competitions throughout this spring, summer and fall. Watch the calendar!

<u>OUTDOOR TRAINING BAYS:</u> We continue to improve the outdoor training bays. They are used for classes, IDPA and if no classes are going on, they are available to the members.

<u>ELECTRONIC TRANSACTIONS</u>: The Club now has a means to securely process electronic transactions. You can submit your membership renewal either with a traditional paper check, or you can pay with a credit card. Credit card information is destroyed upon approval of payment.

Work Program

- 1. Work parties will be scheduled every 3rd Saturday of the month. All work parties will start at 8:00 A.M.
- 2. If you participate in one work party, you will receive a \$25 credit on the following year's annual renewal.

Guest / Visitor Pass and Waiver Policy

- 1. All guests shall pay five dollars (\$5.00) per visit for use of the indoor range or outdoor lower rifle range (300 yard range) so long as the accompanying club member is in current good standing with either of these facilities. The guest fee for the long range (1100 yard range) is \$20 and must be accompanied by a member who is in current good standing with the long range facility.
- 2. With the exception of immediate family, **spouse and children under 18 years of age**, (a spouse who is an avid shooter should consider membership) a member will not bring more than **two (2) guests** at one time on to club property. Waivers and fees are to be deposited in boxes that are available in the indoor range of the Club House and in the shed just inside the gate.
- 3. Club member and adult guests shall execute a Liability Waiver upon entering club grounds. The waiver shall be witnessed by the club member escorting the guest. The guest and club member shall also complete the adhesive Guest Pass which shall be conspicuously displayed on the guest while on club property.
- 4. All League Captains shall be responsible to assure that nonmember participants execute the waiver for up to the end of League activity for the season.
